

Village of Parkway Collection Guidelines

Prepare for Pickup

Set Out Time: Collection day for all services is **THURSDAY**. All carts should be curbside by **6:00 AM**.

Materials: All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided garbage cart. Any items placed outside the cart will **NOT** be collected. (Extra carts may be requested for an additional monthly fee.)

Weight Limits: Cart weight **CANNOT** exceed sixty (60) lb. each.

Cart Placement: Carts **MUST** be **LESS THAN** three (3) ft. away from the street curb and **MUST** be **AT LEAST** three (3) ft. away from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, automobiles, and other waste containers).

Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

Holidays Observed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Recycling

Recycling is collected **every other week** (1st and 3rd week of the month). **NO GLASS.**

Yard Waste

Yard Waste is collected **every other week** (2nd and 4th week of the month) from April to November. Accepted materials are leaves, grass, and small limbs and branches. Bag or containerize all loose material in cans or biodegradable paper bags. Neatly stack larger materials. Weight for each bag or container is limited to 60 lb.

Bulk Waste and White Goods

Meridian Waste will collect one bulk waste item at no charge, once per month on the last Thursday of the month. "Bulky" waste items are objects too big for the garbage cart, such as sofas, chairs, toilets, sinks, bicycles, mattresses, carpet, fencing, and large household furnishings.

Pickup of "white goods" (large appliances such as refrigerators and stoves) is \$30 per item. Call Customer Care to schedule.

City-Wide Clean-Up Events

Each Spring & Fall there will be a city-wide clean up event so that residents may dispose of certain additional items at no additional cost. See website for updates.



Garbage Restrictions

APPROVED Waste

- YES** — Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- YES** — Food scraps and food packaging
- YES** — Disposables
- YES** — Clothing
- YES** — Compost
- YES** — Bottles, cans, newspapers, magazines
- YES** — Glass

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** — Yard waste
- NO** — **Hazardous Materials:** Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)
- NO** — Empty Hazardous Material Containers
- NO** — Radioactive Materials
- NO** — Biological/Medical Waste
- NO** — **Electronic Waste:** Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO** — Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- NO** — Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO** — Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- NO** — Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO** — Automobile Bodies
